About this guide

This three-page guide is prepared by AI Lesson for document-reading practice. All venue details are synthetic. It contains no real visitor or company information. The rules below belong only to this practice case.

Opening times

The galleries are open Tuesday to Sunday, 10:00-17:00. Last gallery entry is at 16:00. The centre is closed on Mondays. Allow around 60-90 minutes for a self-guided gallery visit.

Booking and arrival

Groups of eight or more must book their gallery visit in advance. Smaller groups may visit without a group booking, subject to gallery capacity on arrival. A gallery visit does not reserve a workshop place.

Getting here

The main entrance is on Willow Lane. Cycle stands are beside the main entrance. There is no visitor car park. Local transport routes are not included in this guide.

Gallery etiquette

Keep large bags at the staffed desk and do not touch exhibits unless an activity label invites you to do so. Photography without flash is allowed in the permanent galleries; temporary exhibitions may have separate signs.

Access and activities

Step-free route

Use the garden entrance for step-free access to the ground-floor galleries and accessible toilet. This entrance is open during gallery hours. The first-floor studio is reached by stairs only; there is no lift.

Saturday activities

Activity times below are separate from gallery opening times. Places in bookable activities must be confirmed by the centre before attending.

Workshop materials

Printmaking materials are supplied for confirmed workshop participants. The workshop is a separate activity, not part of ordinary gallery entry.

Food and practical questions

Food and drinks

Visitors may eat their own food at the outdoor picnic tables. These tables cannot be reserved. Own food may not be eaten in the galleries or cafe. The cafe sells drinks and light meals; opening times may differ from gallery hours.

If it rains

The outdoor picnic tables are not covered. This guide does not identify an indoor space where visitors may eat their own food. Ask the centre about alternatives before relying on an indoor lunch plan.

Before you come

If you need a particular arrangement, ask the centre before travelling. Include your intended day and time, group size and the arrangement you need. Do not treat this guide as confirmation of a reservation or of an individual access requirement.
